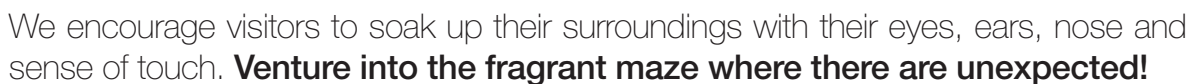


to the Gardens of the International Perfume Museum.

This 2.7 ha open-air museum welcomes visitors for **a unique olfactory and sensory experience**. It is home to botanical collections that have been graced with many new additions in recent years. There are two kinds of plant here: **perfume plants**, used to make perfumes, and **scented plants**, which are a source of inspiration for perfumers. They are grouped into olfactory families. **The tree diagram below shows a classification of the natural olfactory raw:**
